### **III. Quality Assessment**

A quality assessment will be conducted by a Reviewer on UDS reports submitted in a timely manner. The UDS Reviewer will review the data submitted and identify data reporting errors and inconsistencies that must be corrected or explained by the grantee within the EHB. No further revisions will be accepted by grantees after the March 31, 2010 deadline.

Grantees will have the opportunity to work directly with assigned Reviewers. Technical assistance can be requested as early as January and grantees who need to reach the assigned Reviewer or who have not heard from the UDS Reviewer within 2 weeks of submission should contact the UDS Support Line at 866-837-4357 or [udshelp330@bphcdata.net](mailto:udshelp330@bphcdata.net) for further assistance.
