# Montana Prescription Drug Registry (MPDR)

#### What?

 A registry of controlled substance prescriptions dispensed to patients as reported by Montana licensed pharmacies.

#### • Who?

- All Montana licensed prescribers and dispensers are required to register with the MPDR and can access their patients' prescription information.
- All Montana licensed pharmacies/dispensers are required to submit prescription information.
- The Montana Board of Pharmacy maintains and administers the MPDR.

### · Why?

- To improve patient safety.
- To identify possible misuse or diversion of controlled substances.



## **MPDR Information**

#### What information is available?

- Controlled substance prescriptions dispensed by Montana licensed pharmacies, Veterans Health Administration and Indian Health Service.
- Prescription data from 29 states (including all border states) and the Military Health System.

### What information is not available?

- Medications administered in a hospital or clinic setting.
- Medications administered or dispensed from opioid treatment programs.
- Veterinarian prescriptions



# **MPDR Related Prescribing Regulations**

- Mandatory Registration and Fee Payment All Montana licensees authorized to prescribe or dispense prescription drugs are required to register with the MPDR, Montana Code Annotated (MCA) MCA 37-7-1503, and pay the annual \$30 MPDR fee at the time of license renewal, MCA 37-7-1511.
- Prescriber Mandatory Use of the Prescription Drug Registry (MCA 37-7-1515) A
  prescriber, or an agent of the prescriber, is required to search a patient's MPDR
  record before issuing a prescription for an opioid or a benzodiazepines to the patient,
  except in certain circumstances.
- Restriction On Prescriptions For Opioid-Naive Patients (MCA 37-2-108) When a medical practitioner or a naturopathic physician prescribes an opioid to an opioid-naive patient on an outpatient basis, the prescription may not be for more than a 7-day supply except in certain circumstances.



## **MPDR Tools**

- MPDR Integration into Health Information Systems
  - Streamlined access to MPDR information through electronic health records, pharmacy dispensing software or health information exchange.
- NarxCare Scores and Graphs
  - Scores and graphs summarizing a patient's medication history.
- MyRx Search Report
  - Report of all prescriptions in the registry attributed to a DEA number.
- Prescriber Reports
  - Quarterly report of a provider's prescribing habits compared to peers.
